The Conneaut Boat Club accepts no liability for the proper lift of the vessel to or from a trailer, jacks-stands or water.

The Conneaut Boat Club reserves the right to refuse to launch or retrieve any vessel, owned by a member or non-member, if the lift is determined to be dangerous and places the property and safety of the club in jeopardy or proof of valid, adequate insurance cannot be presented at time of lift. The Conneaut Port Authority requires all vessels docked in the Conneaut Lagoon to have adequate insurance.
